



FRUITING BUSHES

<u>COMMON NAME</u>	<u>DESCRIPTION</u>
Asparagus -Mary Washington	Hardy, long lived & heavy producer. Strong 2 year old roots.
Asparagus - Viking	
Blackberry – Black Satin	Thornless plant producing berries that ripen in July.
Blueberries	*Require acid soil. Must be cross pollinated by same bloom time different cultivar. High bush grow up to 3m, Low bush are less than 1m and have “Wild” flavor.
Blue Crop (High bush)	Large, slightly tart. Mid-season with consistent yields and disease resistance.
Blue Ray (High bush)	Large dessert quality berries. Early to mid season.
Bluejay	Early to mid season berry with light blue, medium to large fruit. Mild flavor.
Duke	Self pollinating
Jersey (High bush)	Heavy producing, late season variety. Very sweet, good for baking.
Nelson	Large berries, late season.
Northcountry (Low bush)	Sweet and mild, sky blue colour.
Northland (Low bush)	High sugar content, good for jams & baking. Early.
Patriot (High bush)	Very large, slightly flat fruit.
St. Cloud (Low bush)	Flavour and firmness great.
Current – Black Wellington	Soft medium to large black fruit. Abundance of fruit.
Current – Red Lake	Large bright red berries. Good for jams/jellies.
Current – White Pearl	White fruit, good for jam/jelly and wine.
Elderberry – Adam’s	Large berries, heavy producer.
Elderberry – Korsor	
Gooseberry – Pixwell	Pale green fruit, pink when ripe produced on old wood mid summer. Used for jelly.

Canadice (Seedless)	Early red, eating.
Chardonnay	One of the hardest white viniferas. Ripens mid season. Wine.
Concord	Medium-large blue/black berry. Juicy & sweet. For eating, cooking/baking & juice. Ripen late October.
Himrod (Seedless)	Yellow gold, ripens mid/late September. Eating.
Interlaken (Seedless)	Golden yellow medium size fruit.
Merlot	Red, early, wine.
Niagara	White, large and very sweet. Ripens late September. Eating & juice.
Sovereign Coronation (Seedless)	Blue ripens mid September. Eating.

Suffolk (Seedless)	Red, eating.
Vanessa (Seedless)	Red, ripens mid September, eating.
Horse Radish	Full sun, grows 60cm high by 40cm wide, harvest whole plant after frost
Jerusalum Artichoke	Flowers ornamental, use the tuber like roots like potatoes
Josta Berry	Cross between black current and gooseberry. Ripens late July.
Kiwi – Hardy Issai	Unique, self-fertile variety that bears fruit after 1 year. Use as a vine, pick after frost.
Raspberry – Fall Gold Everbearing	Large golden yellow, juicy sweet fruit.
Raspberry – Heritage Everbearing	Vigorous grower with medium sized red fruit.
Raspberry - Boyne	Medium sized fruit. Suitable for canning/freezing/dessert. Ripens July.

Raspberry – Latham	Very large berries, ripen over a long period.
Rhubarb – Canada Red	Bright red stocks. Suitable for colder areas.
Rhubarb – German Wine	Large plump stalks are dark red & very sweet.

Strawberry – Redcoat	Use for jams.
Strawberry – Seascape Everbearing	Large fruit, high yield, good flavor.
Strawberry – Veestar	Early, very productive variety.
